Class Description

Parenting Through Separation and Divorce is a class designed at the request of the courts to help divorcing couples understand the problems their children may experience during and after a divorce and/or separation. This class will fulfill the blanket court order for all divorcing parents.

Material will be presented in a classroom format. Information includes skills for relating to divorce issues, children's responses to divorce, communication skills and guidelines for cooperative parenting. Participants will learn skills and guidelines for cooperative parenting.

Each class begins at 6:00 p.m. and concludes at 9:00 p.m., with hourly breaks. Certificates will also be presented as proof of completion. The course costs \$35.00 per person to be paid at time of class.





Family Specific Topics
